2017 Breaux Bridge Jambalaya Cook-Off Rules

Saturday, September 30, 2017

- All fees and entry forms must be collected prior or morning of the event.
- Teams may begin check in at 7:00 am. Cooking can begin after registration.
- Each team may consist of 1-4 contestants. 4 wrists bands will be issued to each team. Additional guests must pay \$10 admission into the cook-off.
- The Jambalaya must be cooked on Cook-off Grounds. This is an outdoor cook-off event. Each team is responsible for their own shelter, tables, chairs, etc.
- Each team must supply all ingredients and utensils for cooking. Each jambalaya must contain a minimum of 5 pounds of protein.
- BBACC will provide each team with 4-ounce bowls, forks, and napkins. They will also provide each team with the appropriate containers for judges.
- Teams must keep areas clean during the event and are responsible for cleaning their own cooking areas at the end of the event.
- There will be a cash bar on site (no outside drinks can be brought in) we will have discounted case prices available for teams – prices will be similar to what you would pay at the store.
- Judges Sample Turn In at 12:00 pm
- Serving the Public Begins at 12:00 pm
- Award Ceremony begins at 3:00 pm
- Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category, and a Grand Prize for Overall Winner
